Large Antique Wall Clock, Munn & Son, Sheerness



A late 19th century public display clock which would have graced the wall of a public space such as a bank, school, library or waiting area. The clock has a bold 13-inch diameter dial and a substantial mahogany case. A large antique wall clock such as this would look great in a large open living area like a barn conversion or industrial setting, or indeed any large kitchen or hall.

The eight-day chain fusee movement has rectangular brass plates, and the original pendulum. The movement is to be overhauled and guaranteed for 3 years.

The mahogany case has a swan neck pediment and a reed carved surround. Although one piece, it appears top sit on a pair of brackets;

The larger than average painted steel Roman dial is inscribed Munn & Son, Sheerness.

William Munn of Sheerness had a long history of clockmaking. The name first appears in the 1847 Bagshaw's History, Gazetteer & Directory of Kent trade directory in the Watch & Clock Makers section at Sheerness.

Munn & Son of Sheerness filed for bankruptcy in January 1932.
