

Antique Silvered Four Glass Mantel Clock



Silver-plated French four glass clock by Roblin of Paris, dated c.1900.

The four glass case is of small proportions. It has been newly silver-plated and lacquered and has bevelled glasses to all four sides, all in pristine condition.

The 8-day movement strikes the hours and the half hours on a bell. The movement is stamped *Roblin & Fils, Freres a Paris* to the back plate in an oval.

The two piece enamel dial remain perfect, with Roman numerals and with the centre of the dial showing the escapement. Blued steel Breguet-style hands.

The compensating pendulum comprises two sealed vials filled with mercury.
