INSTRUCTIONS FOR SETTING UP THE GRANDMOTHER CLOCK

Hang the pendulum onto the movement as shown:





Now, VERY CAREFULLY place the clock where it is to be positioned, keeping it as upright as possible, so without swinging the pendulum.

Placing a spirit level across the top of the clock as in the photo, level the clock by placing shims (or coins) under any part of the base that requires it.



Wind all three springs up fully as far as you can go, through the dial.

Give the pendulum a small impulse to set the clock ticking. The clock has been set up to a spirit level here and testing very accurately. If the clock is level, you should hear a very even tick. If not, you may need to put another coin or similar under one side.

<u>To set the hands to time:</u> These movements need to chime out each quarter. Turning the MINUTE HAND only, and CLOCKWISE only, turn forwards a quarter hour at a time, waiting for the chimes to play each time.

Wind the clock (all three springs) once a week.
